TRANSFORMING SERVICES are donor funded, enhance our core services, are critical to our successful outcomes, and help transform lives.

COMMUNITY SERVICES provide a broad range of quality treatment to children and families in West Michigan. These programs are funded through public contract sources and can be utilized by anyone in our community.

EDUCATION SERVICES provide education to residential clients, students in the community, Wedgwood staff, and community professionals.

RESIDENTIAL SERVICES provide a safe place for kids to heal from the trauma of severe abuse and neglect, exploitation, and substance abuse.







Transforming Services

Chaplaincy & Young Life

- 100% of clients receive a visit from a Wedgwood Chaplain within one week of admission
- ▶ 100% of clients visit the Nagel Chapel and have an opportunity to use the Coffee House and Kids Club
- ▶ 90% of Residential clients consistently participate in optional worship services, Bible studies, and other activities
- 75% of clients request Bibles while at Wedgwood







Recreation & Wellness

Up to **82**% of children in residential programs received **Occupational Therapy (OT)** to improve their social and fine motor skills.

100% of children participated in therapeutic activities that promote their physical, mental, and emotional growth and health.



Wedgwood's Teen CHARGE is a student leadership group that promotes peer-to-peer education, encourages positive choices, and empowers teens.

Wedgwood's Manasseh Project

on the risk factors, signs, implications and best practices for treatment of commercial sexual exploitation.




Employment Training Program

- ► Teens in ETP worked a total of 14,070 hours
- Teens served 447 community customers through a variety of services
- Teens made 24 picnic tables for Frederik Meijer Gardens and Sculpture Park

Community Services

Through **20** different professional counseling and prevention services, Wedgwood's Community Services enables thousands of children, teens, and families in our community to lead healthy, and hope-filled lives.



Trauma-Focused Services

- 75 families received Trauma Focused Cognitive Behavioral Therapy (TF-CBT)
- 65 families participated in Trauma Informed Parenting, a parenting class offered to parents/caregivers who have children who have experienced trauma, and are part of their healing process.





Positive Youth Development (PYD)

Wedgwood offers 3 main prevention programs -

- Project SUCCESS (Substance Use Prevention)
 - Active in 3 schools
- Real Essentials (Sexual Risk Avoidance)
- Teen CHARGE (Student Leadership Program)

that served over **6,200** youth and families. The team provided **200** resource bags for families through lunch pick-up.

Autism Center For Child Development (ACCO)



- A child is typically enrolled in Wedgwood's ACCD for 3 years.
- 33 children received Applied Behavior Analysis (ABA) therapy.
- ▶ 25% of children graduate from Wedgwood's ACCD and transition into general education classrooms.
- ▶ 100% of children transition into less intensive programs.
- 5 Board Certified Behavior Analysts (BCBA) oversee treatment,
 3 Board Certified assistant Behavior Analysts (BCaBA) and 28
 Registered Behavior Technicians work one-on-one with children.







Community Services

Substance Use Disonden Treatment

Wedgwood Christian Services offers 10 Substance Use Disorder (SUD) programs for adolescents and families and has provided treatment for 1,173 clients in 9 West Michigan counties.

The **Wedgwood Institute** offers diverse continuing education to Wedgwood employees and to other community professionals who work with children, teens, and families.

1,297 professionals received training in **101** classes and trainings.

Wedgwood Foundation

The **Wedgwood Foundation** was founded in *1990* to support the mission of Wedgwood Christian Services.



Wedgwood's Legacy Society is made up of **101** members who have informed Wedgwood they are planning on leaving Wedgwood with a potential charitable gift from their estate.


