

2009 HIGHLIGHTS

Wedgwood served **9,381** people across 37 Michigan counties

Wedgwood treated **1,326** (+15%) youth through residential, foster care, independent living, and home based services

Wedgwood provided a home for **908** (+13%) youth who could not live at home with their families (residential, foster care, independent living)

Wedgwood treated **367** youth in their homes to avoid family disruption and out of home care

Wedgwood treated **167** (+16%) youth in intensive substance abuse outpatient services

Wedgwood provided **342** (+138%) youth & adults mental health outpatient counseling

Wedgwood community prevention efforts impacted **4,925** local teens & adults through abstinence, mentoring & outreach programs

Lighthouse Academy, a special on-campus charter school enrolled **250** (+65%) expelled and at-risk students

2009 PROGRAM STATISTICS

COMMUNITY SERVICES: 5,926 youth & families served

Prevention Services:

1,770 youth and **300** adults participated in substance abuse prevention groups

1,375 youth and **250** adults were impacted by sexual abstinence prevention programs

45 youth participated in group mentoring

1,100 youth and **85** adults were impacted by the "Pure Passion for Fashion" community event

Outpatient Counseling:

167 youth were served in intensive outpatient substance abuse treatment

342 individuals received outpatient mental health or substance abuse counseling services

In Home Services:

51 youth served in juvenile justice diversion, reintegration, and restorative justice services

367 families served in community mental health home-based treatment services

Foster Care:

51 youth treated and cared for

Independent Living Services:

23 youth served

EDUCATION: 2,621 served

Lighthouse Academy:

Wedgwood provided support services to *Lighthouse Academy*, a special on-campus charter school, meeting the educational and counseling needs of **250** expelled and educationally at-risk students and their families.

Wedgwood Institute:

The *Wedgwood Institute* provided **205** sessions of social work training to **2,371** staff, foster parents and community professionals.

RESIDENTIAL TREATMENT: 834 youth served

234 youth needed emergency residential shelter, crisis stabilization or respite care

49 youth were treated for sexual behavior problems

94 youth were served in our substance abuse treatment program

318 additional youth were served in Wedgwood's secure and open campus residential treatment programs

139 youth were treated in 2 newly established group homes in the community
