

2007 HIGHLIGHTS

Wedgwood ministered to **21,706** people across 37 Michigan counties

Wedgwood treated **1147** youth in residential, foster care, independent living, and home based services

Wedgwood provided a home for **872** youth who could not live at home with their families (residential, foster care, independent living)

Wedgwood treated **275** youth in their homes to avoid family disruption and out of home care

Wedgwood treated **113** youth in intensive substance abuse outpatient services

Wedgwood provided **3588** individual services for youth & adults in mental health outpatient services

Wedgwood's Positive Youth Development Programs (prevention and outreach services) touched the lives of more than **16,306** local youth and **461** adults through its church/community based abstinence, life-skills, teen outreach, teen mentoring programs, and community outreach event

2007 PROGRAM STATISTICS

Residential Treatment: 657 Youth Served

122 youth needed emergency residential shelter, crisis stabilization or respite care

71 youth were served in our residential Family Empowerment Program (Boelkins Home)

46 youth were served in our Crossroads Sex Offender Program

129 youth were served in our Summit Substance Use Disorder Program

289 additional youth were served in Wedgwood's secure or open campus residential treatment programs

44 youth served in juvenile justice diversion, reintegration, and restorative justice services
