

2008 HIGHLIGHTS

Wedgwood ministered to **15,241** people across 37 Michigan counties

Wedgwood treated **1,150** youth through residential, foster care, independent living, and home based services

Wedgwood provided a home for **804** youth who could not live at home with their families (residential, foster care, independent living)

Wedgwood treated **389** youth in their homes to avoid family disruption and out of home care

Wedgwood treated **144** youth in intensive substance abuse outpatient services

Wedgwood provided **3,202** youth & adults mental health outpatient services

Wedgwood community prevention efforts impacted **8,111** local teens & adults through abstinence, mentoring & outreach programs

Lighthouse Academy became a special charter school and doubled its capacity, enrolling **100** students

2008 PROGRAM STATISTICS

Community-Based Prevention Services - Positive Youth Development: 6,546 Youth & 1,565 Adults Participated

1,152 youth and **300** adults participated in Substance Abuse Prevention groups

2,449 youth and **365** adults were impacted by Sexual Abstinence Prevention programs

45 youth participated in Group Mentoring

2,900 youth and **900** adults were impacted by the "*Pure Passion for Fashion*" community outreach event

Education Services: 2,591 served

Wedgwood provided support services to *Lighthouse Academy*, which became a special charter school, meeting the educational and counseling needs of **100** expelled and educationally at-risk students and their families.

The *Wedgwood Institute* provided 184 sessions of social work training to **2,491** internal & community professionals and foster parents.

Outpatient Counseling: 3,346 Served

144 youth served in adolescent intensive substance abuse outpatient treatment (IOP)

3,202 individual services provided to youth & adults in outpatient mental health or outpatient substance abuse counseling services

In Home Services: 389 Youth or Families Served

43 youth served in juvenile justice diversion, reintegration, and restorative justice services

346 families served in community mental health home-based treatment services

Specialized Foster Care Treatment: 85 Youth Served

Residential Treatment: 693 Youth Served

251 youth needed emergency residential shelter, crisis stabilization or respite care

53 youth were served in our residential Family Empowerment Program

42 youth were served in our Crossroads Sex Offender Program

116 youth were served in our Summit Substance Use Disorder Program

231 additional youth were served in Wedgwood's secure or open campus residential treatment programs
